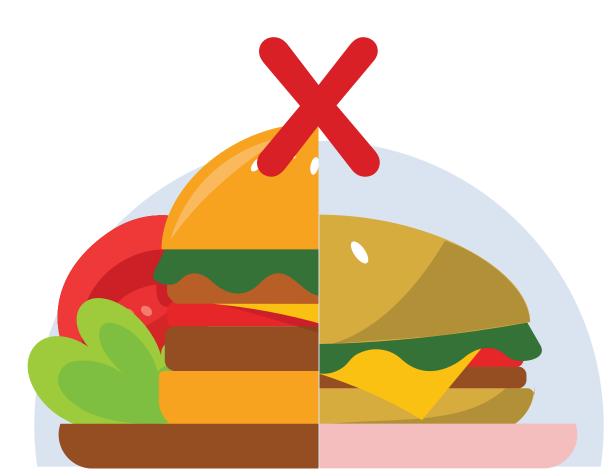

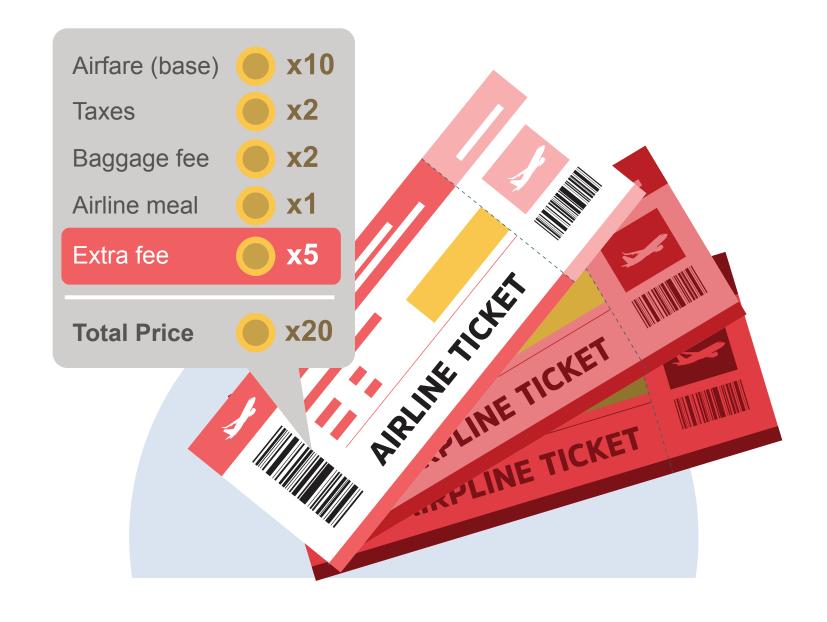












CONSUMERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO ACCURATE INFORMATION ABOUT GOODS AND SERVICES THEY PURCHASE

- Carefully check labels, reviews and price details
- Ask for more explanation from the business
- Alert the consumer protection agency or relevant authorities

Dos:

- State facts and complete information
 - Ingredients:
 Water, Sugar,
 Concentrated
 Orange Juice (6%)
- **Mention limitations** clearly
- Voucher only applies up to 31 December 2020
- Use a language that is easy to understand



Don'ts:

1 Make unproven statements



Provide guarantees that cannot be fulfilled



3 Exclude or conceal important information



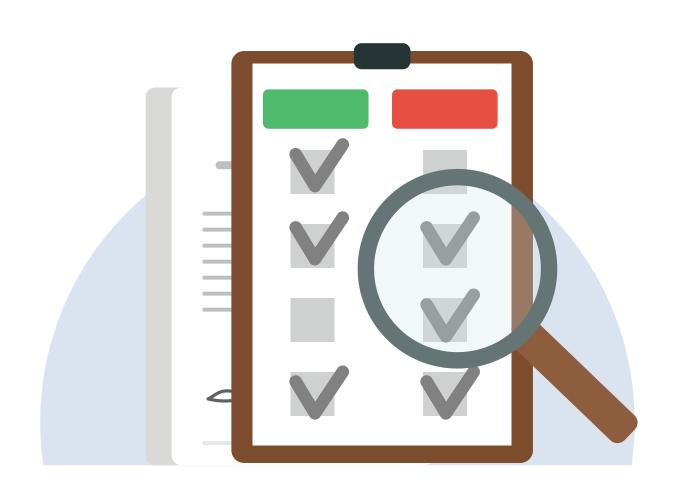
